He subsequently joined ABN AMRO as treasury dealer with primary responsibility for the USD 2 billion money market book of the Bank's Greek subsidiary in all major currencies, including the Greek drachma at the time.

Nikos subsequently moved on to several instrumental positions in the technology space, developing, marketing, and implementing world class technology solutions not only within banking but also the manufacturing and telecoms sectors.

From 2005 onwards, he commenced a series of capital intensive projects in construction, infrastructure, real estate, as well as energy. In his capacity as principal investor as well as executive officer, he ultimately led them to successful implementation by optimizing their capital structures and securing long term funding from a variety of alternative investor sources.
